V103 - Goal Setting and Time Management (2 hours)	This course is one of the requirements for Venturing's Discovery Award for youth. In this course, the youth will learn time management strategies that will enable them to set priorities, organize tasks, and perform work in a timely manner to carry out successful Crew adventures and achieve self-selected goals. 2-Hour Class	Saturday Oct 24 from 2:00 - 3:50 pm (2 hours)
V104 - Mentoring for Venturing (2 hours)	Who is your mentor? What, you don't have a mentor? What is mentor anyway? If you are a member of a Venture Crew or a Venture Advisor, you need to come to Mentoring for Venturers to learn what a mentor is and how you can be an effective mentor. Anyone who has held a leadership position is the perfect candidate to pass the skills you have learned onto your successor(s). This training will make you an effective mentor, both in Venturing and in your personal life. This course will be run by a long time Advisor and several Venturers.
