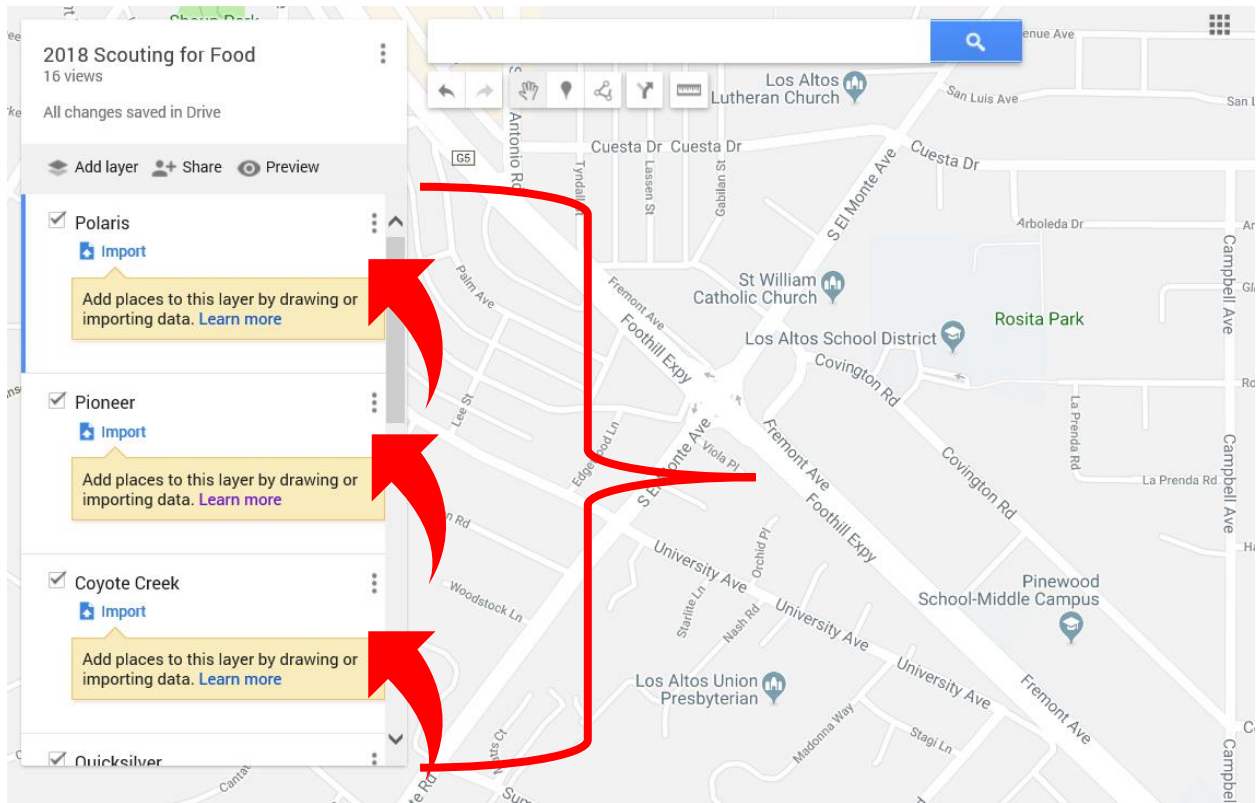

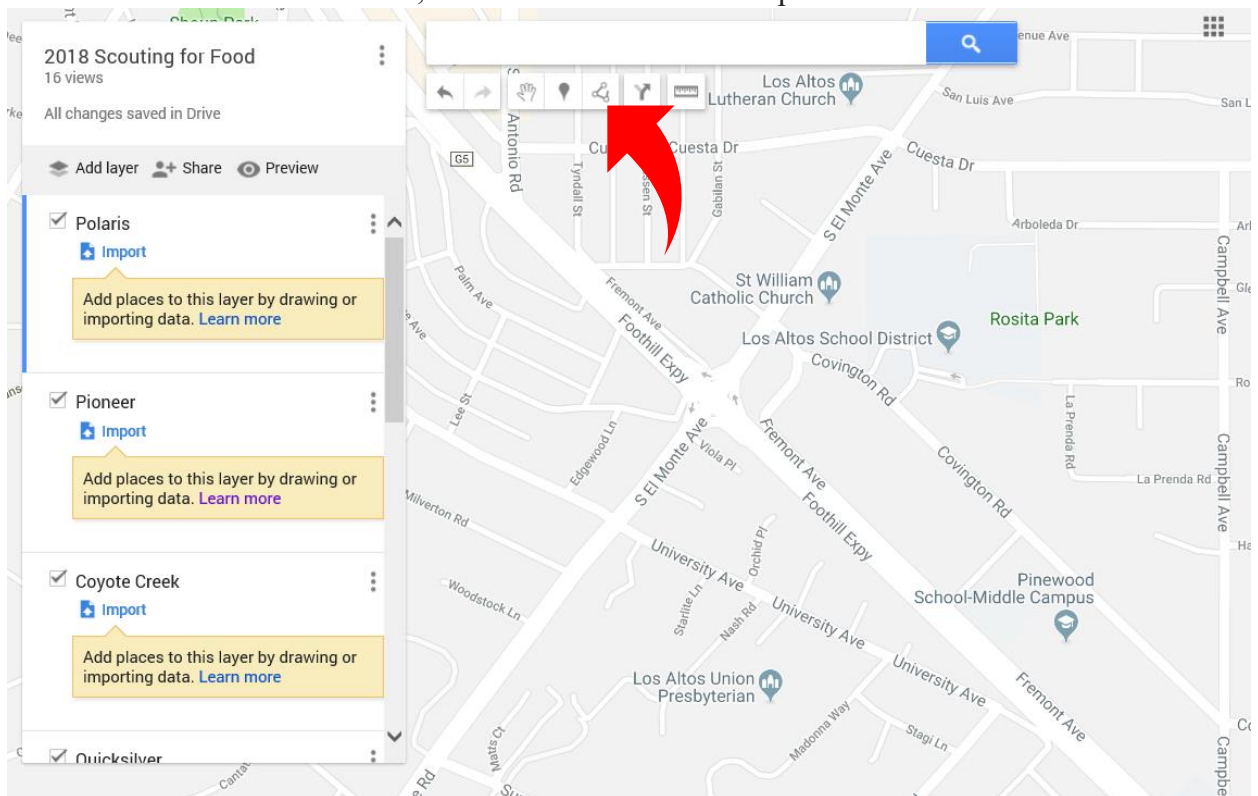


How to mark a region in Google Maps?

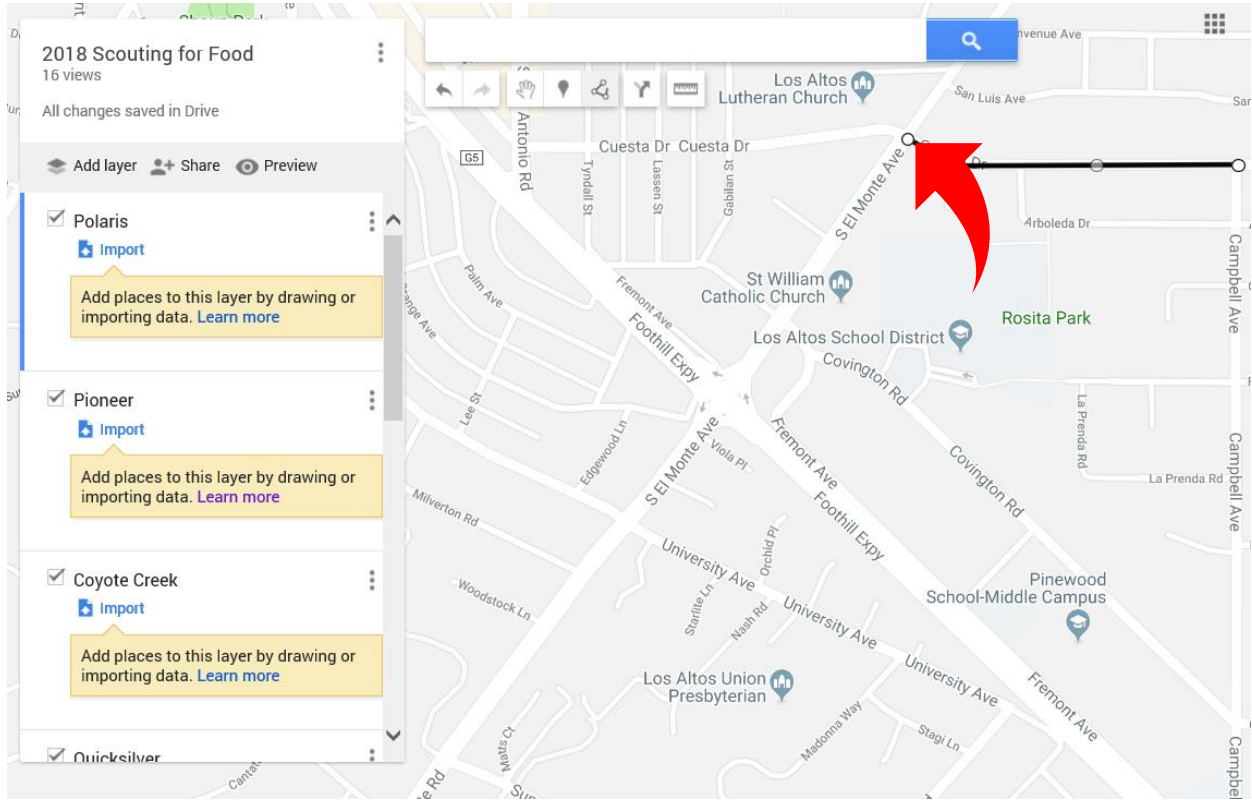
1. Follow this link to open the Google Map named “[2021 Scouting for Food](#)”
2. Log-in with a Google account.
3. Select the Layer with your district’s name from the scroll down menu:



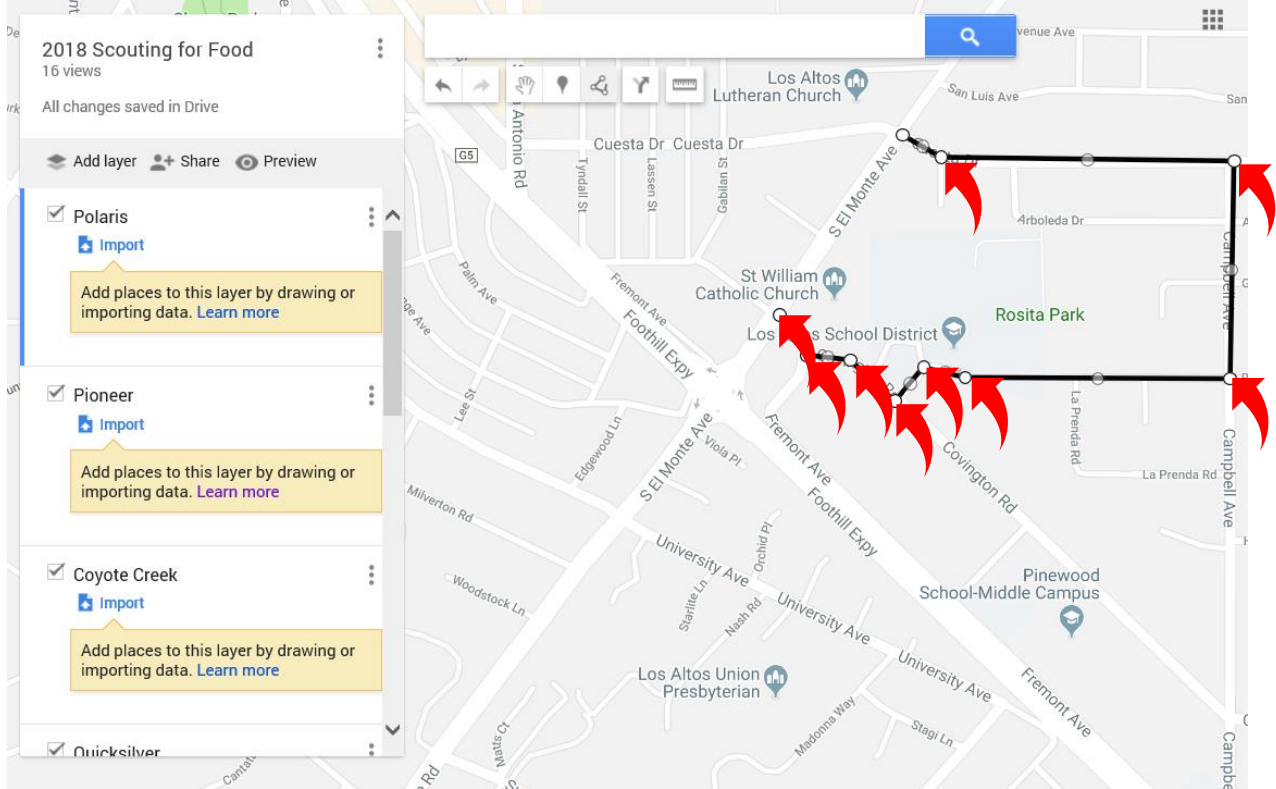
4. Click the “Draw a line” icon , and select “Add line or shape”.



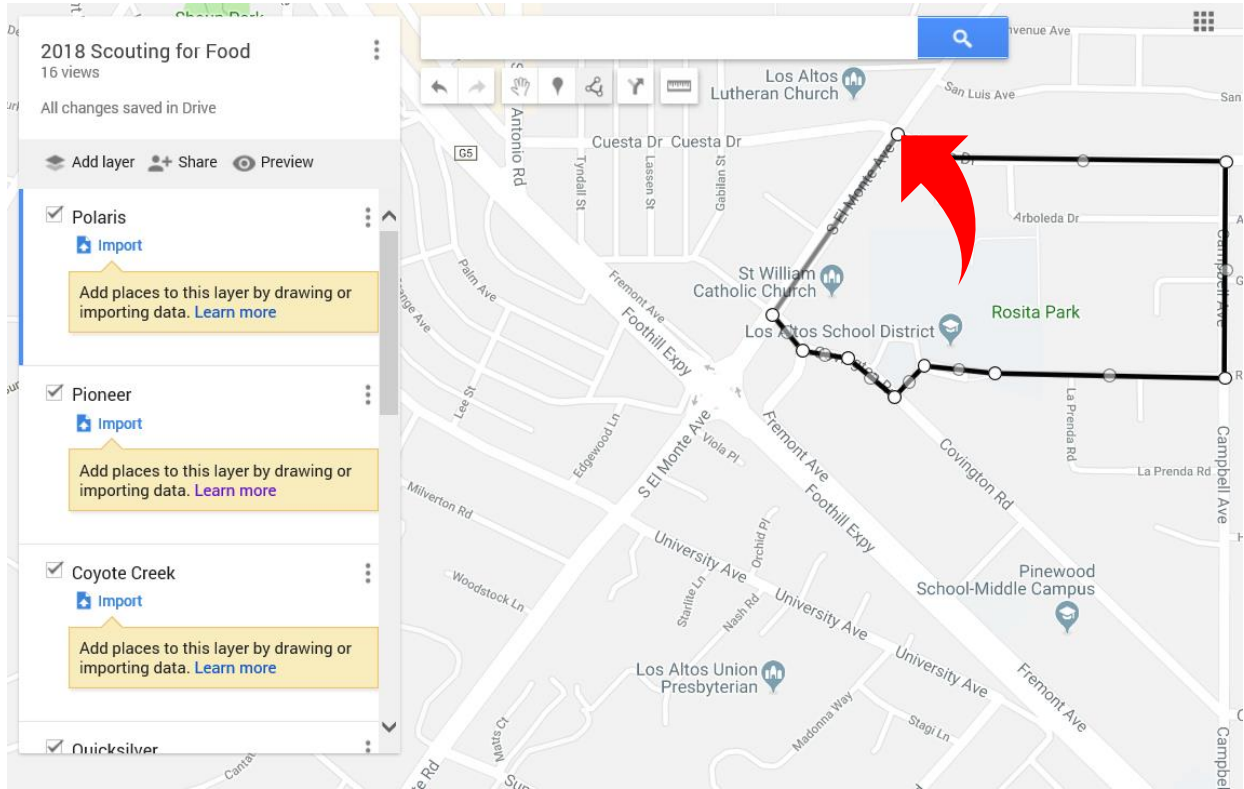
5. Click where you want to start drawing.



6. Click each corner or bend of your line or shape.

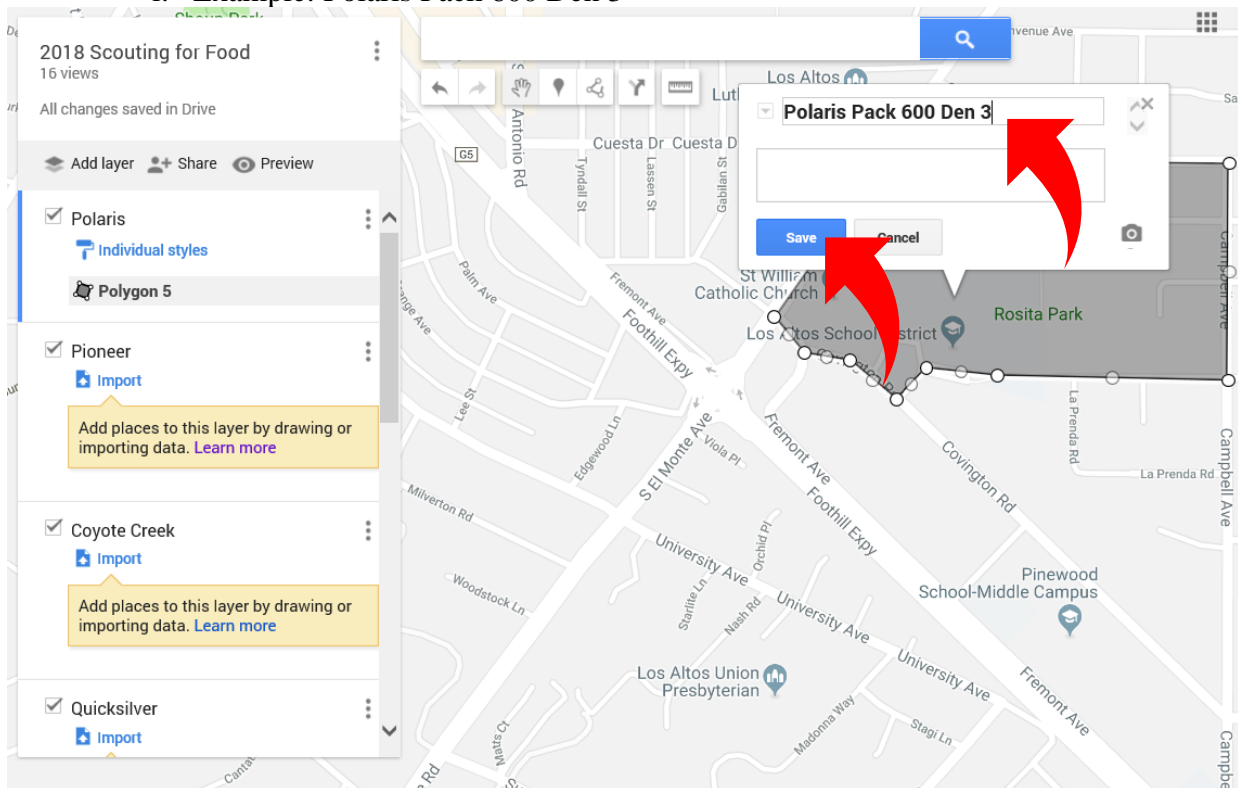


7. Complete the polygon to finish drawing.

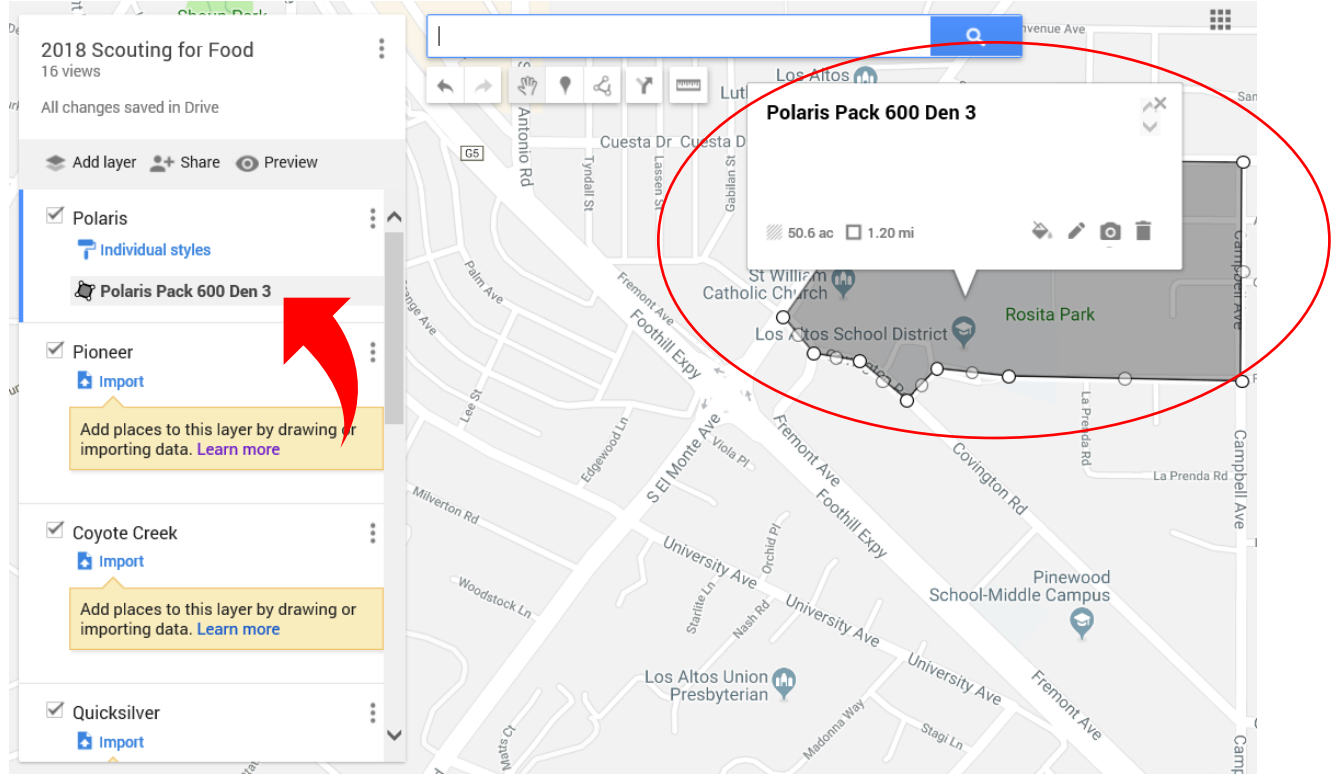


8. Give your polygon a name using the following guidelines. Don't forget to click "Save":

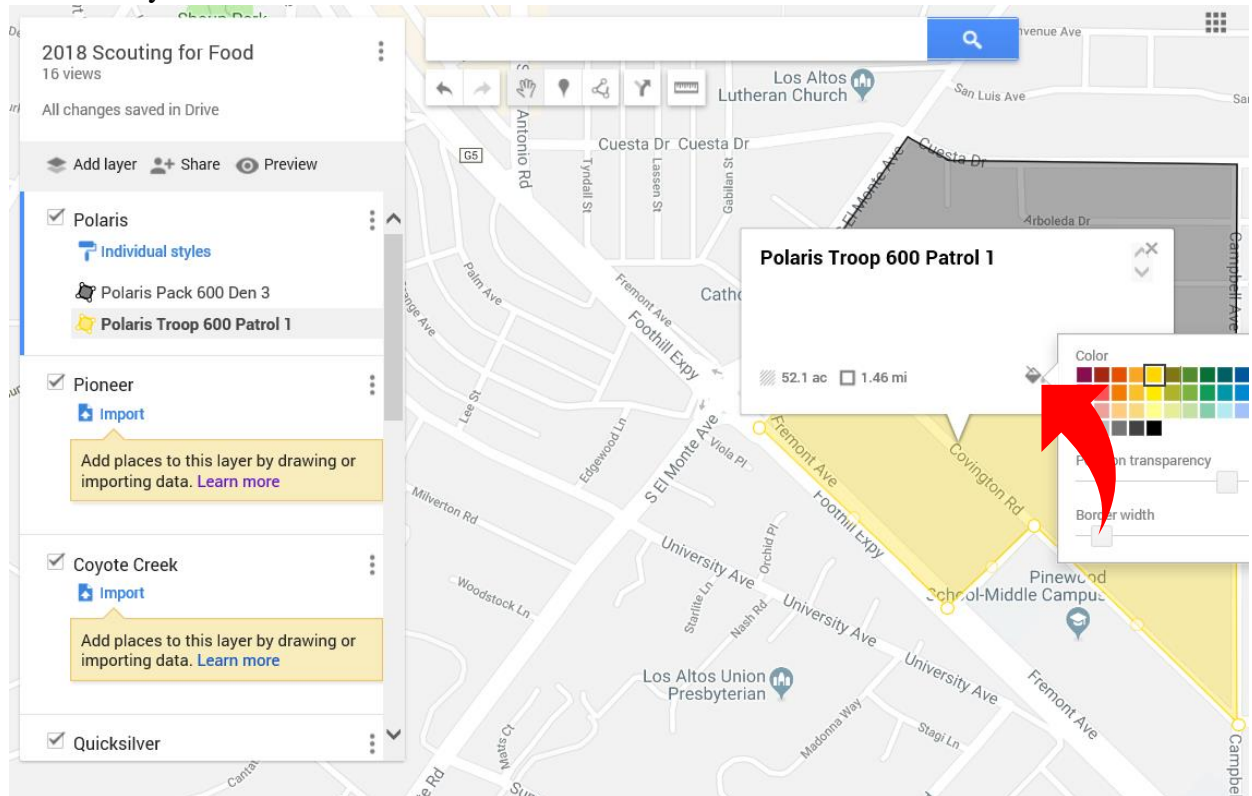
- a. District name
- b. Unit type and number
- c. Den/patrol number if applicable
 - i. Example: Polaris Pack 600 Den 3

10. To add an area adjacent to an existing polygon, simply follow the steps above, name it, and select a different style color:
